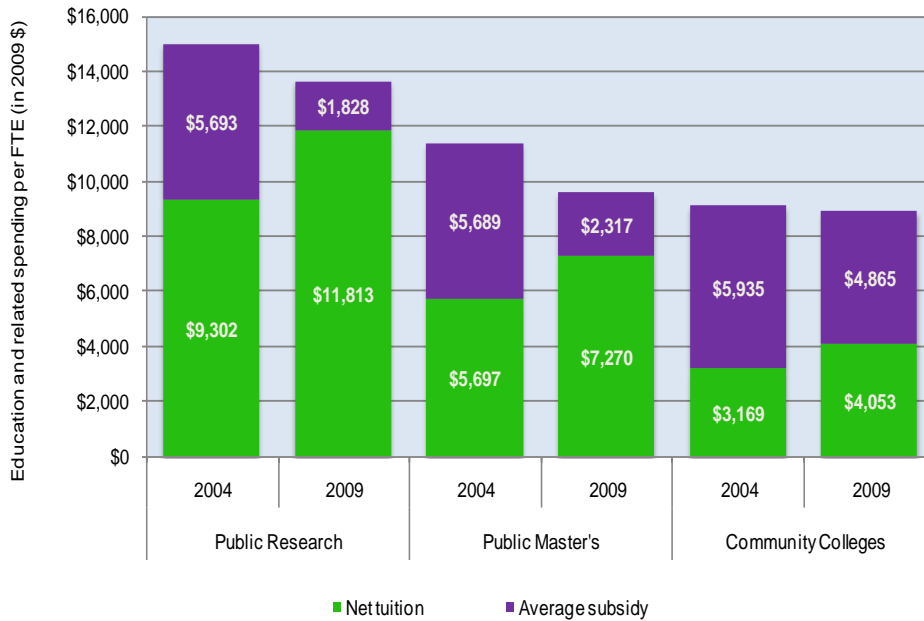


# Rhode Island
